Futuristic objectives of the institution are planned, providing scope and space for timely execution. Towards fulfilling the same, the IQAC has planned for the current academic year, keeping in mind the vision and mission of the institution.

- **To enhance ICT enabled teaching learning activities especially at PG level.**
 - All the PG classes are given ICT enabled teaching. 4 new LCD projectors are added to the PG departments. Group mail-id is created and seminars and assignments are given through online. Wi-Fi connectivity has been extended to few more departments.

- **To introduce online examinations through MCQ and automatic evaluation to start with for CIA for few courses.**
 - Computer related courses are conducting online exams with multiple choice questions and automatic evaluation for their internal component.
- **The management to provide seed money to select departments to promote research culture.**
 - Management has contributed Rs 25,000/ each to the departments for conducting National level Conferences.
- **To encourage staff to publish in journals of international standard and high impact value.**
 - This year 26 staff have published 51 articles in peer reviewed national and international journals with impact factor ranging from 0.057 to 2.7
- **To increase the reading room capacity in library.**
 - Internet lab is being shifted to the new block and hence the reading room capacity of the library will be increased by 55.
- **To increase titles/volumes of books, virtual learning resources/digital or e-library content and subscribe for new journals in the library.**
 - Total Number of Titles : 1431
 - Total Number of Volumes : 1812
 - Total Amount Spent for Books : Rs. 6,31,480
 - Total Number of Journals : 175
 - Total Amount Spent for Journals : Rs. 2,30,766
- **To install 80 new computer systems with backup facilities and peripherals in the new block**
 - A new lab named distributed technologies lab was constructed on 1526 SFT with 81 systems (79 nodes, 1 Server and 1 Backup Server) and UPS to provide Computer facilities for more number of students. The lab is well equipped with 5 nos. of 2 ton AC, advanced hardware equipments and software programmes.
- **To have collaborations with international institutions.**
 - The global competency of the college is evident in the MOU signed between our institution and UMEA university, Sweden from 2009-2012 .

- Ms Ulla Brit Bergstrom, Ms Cristine Issakson, Professors, Social Work Department, Umea University, Sweden visited Cauvery College for Women from 04-01-2011 to 20-01-2011.
- Ms Carlsson Diano Angelica, student of Social Work Department, Umea University, Sweden visited Cauvery College for Women from 01-01-2011 to 04-03-2011.
- Dr. D. Nirmala and Mrs P. Ramya, Asst Professors, Department of Social Work, Cauvery College for Women, Trichy, have planned to visit Umea University Sweden From 18-04-2011 to 31-06-2011.
- Ms. M.Muthulakshmi, Ms.Narmada, are the students from our college pursuing courses at Umea University Sweden from 13-01-2011 to 11-06-2011.
 - MoU signed with Raffles Academy, Singapore
 - A proposal for MoU to be signed for ERASMUS MUNDUS with the European Union.
- **To generate funds through sponsored projects(DST, MHRD, DBT, ICSSR)**
 - Since ours is a self financing institution we are unable to receive funds from these organisations.
- **To provide better financial incentives to teachers to attract best talent.**
 - The salary structure was revised and hence the institution was able to attract best talented and qualified staff.
 - Special incentives are given for MPhil, PhD and University Qualification approved staff.
- **To create outdoor sports and multi gym facilities along with yoga and meditation**
 - Movable netball court has been established in front of the open air stage
 - Yoga classes are conducted separately for students and staff.
- **To provide financial incentives and help to the deserving students.**
 - Management has magnanimously contributed Rs 4,79,495/- for 95 students.
 - CAPSA (Cauvery Past Students Association) has contributed 3,22,600/- for 115 students.
 - 625 books have been distributed to poor students through book bank scheme.

Free boarding and lodging facilities are provided for deserving candidates.
- **To strengthen career guidance and placement cell activities.**

- WIPRO WASE, WIPRO TECHNOLOGIES, RR CAMBRIDGE SCHOOL, AKT ACADEMY SCHOOL, HCL TECHNOLOGIES, TCS BPO, WIPRO WISTA conducted on campus programmes and selected 245 students.
- Our students also participated in off campus programmes conducted by COGNIZANT TECHNOLOGIES, TCS, CTS(BPO), DELL BPO, N TRUST BPO and 53 students were selected.
- **To construct a new seminar hall with seating capacity of 300 in the new block.**
 - The seminar hall is under construction and the work will be completed in the beginning of the next academic year.
- **To construct 14 class rooms in the new block.**
 - 22 new class rooms have been constructed in the ‘G’ Block.
- **Departments and class rooms to be arranged block wise for better management of the students.**
 - Class rooms have been arranged closer to the departments.
- **To organize a national Conference in the Department of Microbiology**
 - Departments of Microbiology, Commerce and Computer Science will be organising the National Conference in the next Academic year.
- **To organize a UGC sponsored Seminar in the Dept of Social Work under the scheme of Human Rights Education.**
 - UGC Sponsored National Seminar On “Sensitising values and Women Rights for Human Development” was organised on 09.07.2010 & 10.07.2010. Around 10 resource persons and 100 members participated in the seminar.
- **To organize a UGC sponsored Symposium in the Dept of Social Work under the scheme of Human Rights Education.**
 - UGC Sponsored Two days National Symposium on “Rights and Care of the Elderly” was organised on 30.09.2010 and 01.10.2010. Around 7 resource persons and 100 members participated in the symposium.
 - UGC sponsored National Conference on Emerging Trends in Women Leadership in India.

The following activities were planned by The Centre for Women Studies

- **To extend special vocational training to the Women Self Help Groups with the view to prepare them as entrepreneur.**
 - The Special functional skills training programme for the self help group members was organized on 31.08.2010 to prepare them as entrepreneurs.
- **To focus its attention towards young entrepreneurs to strengthen them with basic English course to compete with other entrepreneurs in the marketing field.**
 - In the special functional skills training programme Basic English course was taught to the members of self help groups.
- **To Form Self Help Groups among economically backward and needy students and extending support by organizing Entrepreneurial Training Programme to sell their products inside the college campus.**
 - In future action will be taken to form self help groups
- **To organize Special Programmes on gender sensitization to enhance the attitude of gender equity and gender equality among students.**
 - With regard to Gender sensitization, training of trainers programme was organized by the BDU Centre for women's studies on 12th 13th among college students.
- **To concentrate on adopted villages to sensitize the villages on gender issues and strengthen the Women Self Help Groups with more entrepreneurial skills.**
 - During March 8th International Women's day special mobile awareness programme was carried out by the centre in the adopted village Allur (Andanallun Block) in meeting the members of self Help Groups.
- **To establish Special Forum among the students to discuss and deal with Women issues and to strengthen their capacity by organizing basic capacity building programmes.**
 - Student forum has been established in the institution to deal with women issues and also to extend a platform to the students to share their experiences.

- **To support the students by initiating in-house magazine to create an opportunity for them to express their views on various women issues and also to sensitize the society with greater awareness.**
 - The initiative is already taken to prepare in house magazine.
 - With regard to Gender sensitization training of trainers programme was organized by the BDU Centre for women's studies on 12th 13th of August among college students.
