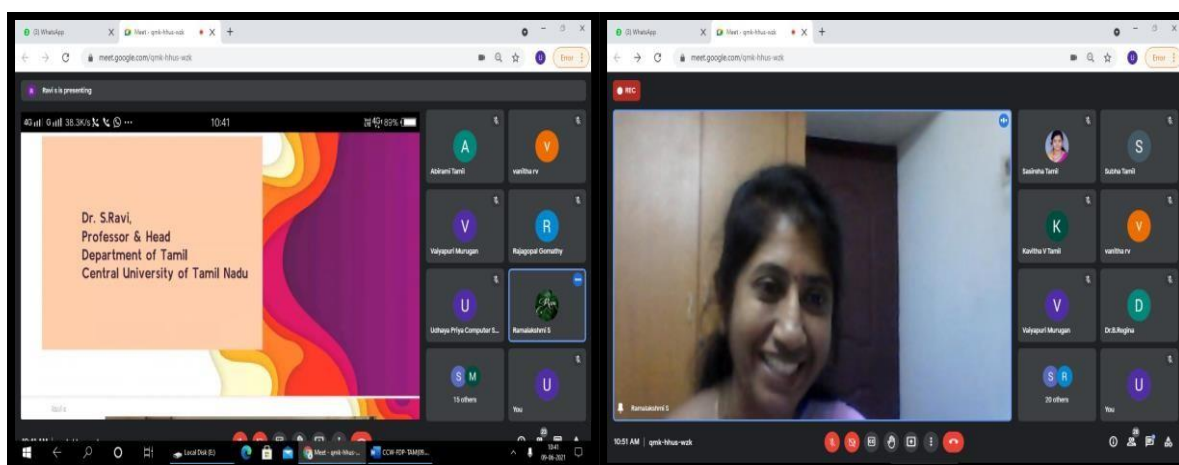


## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

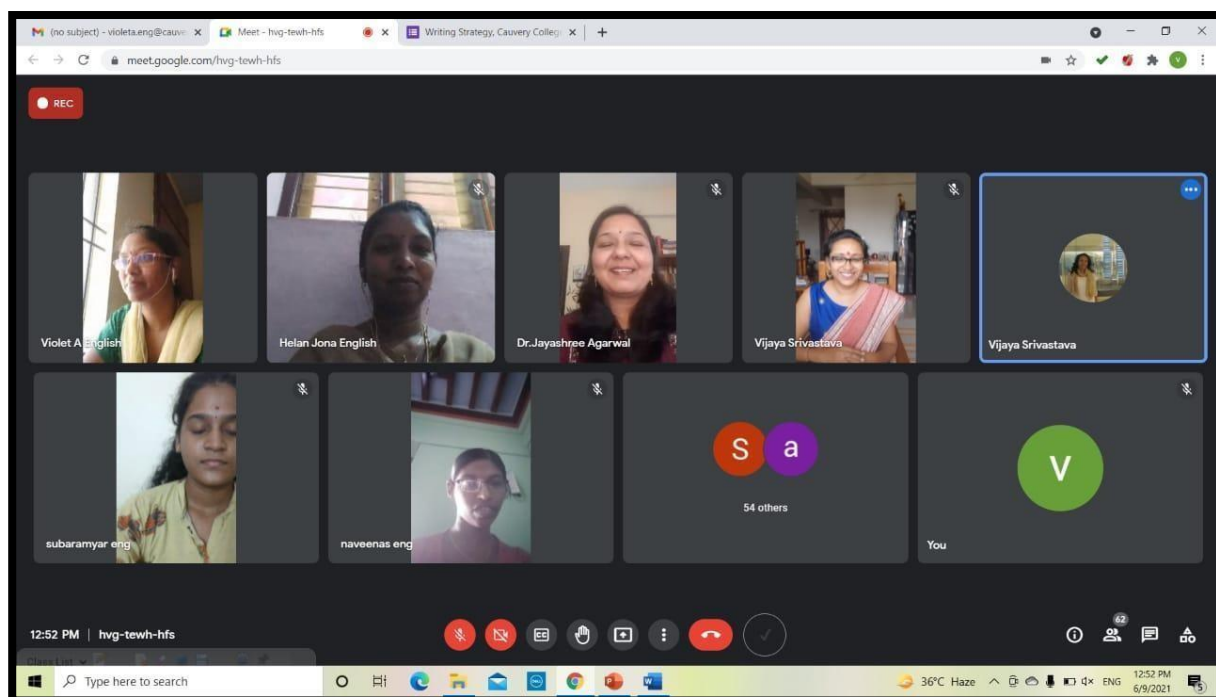
### DEPARTMENT OF TAMIL

## DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

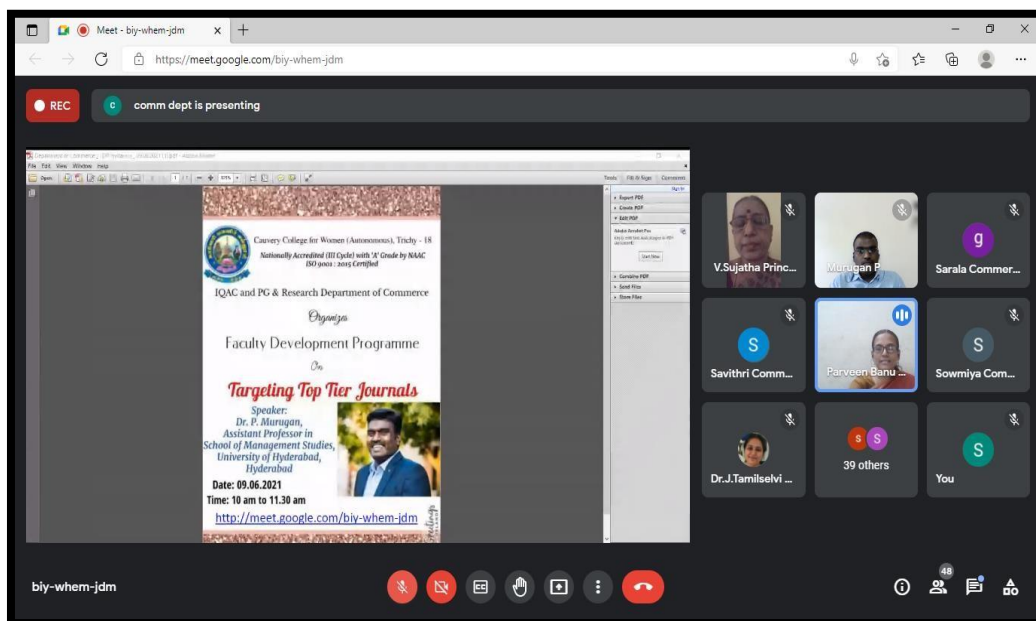

## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

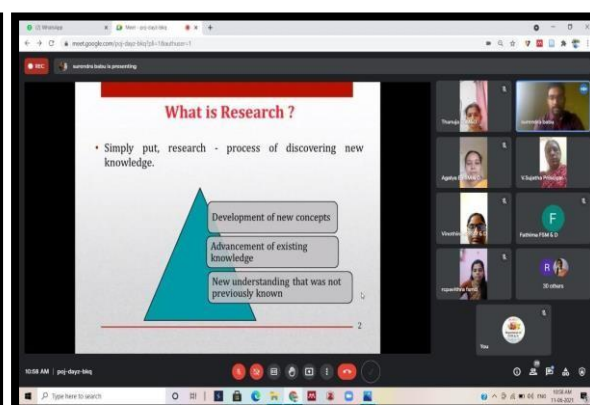
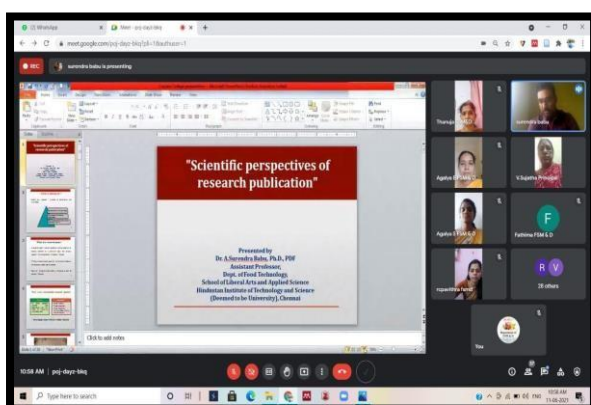

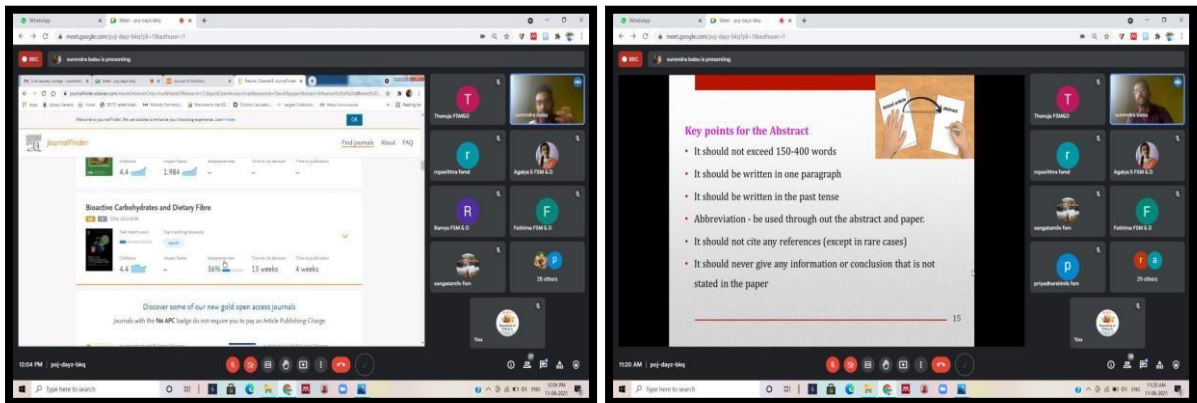




## **DEPARTMENT OF FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT AND DIETETICS**

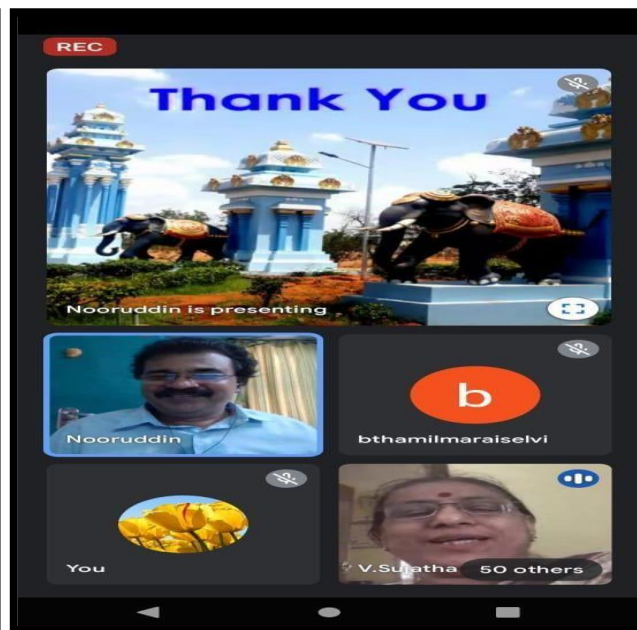




### PG AND RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY

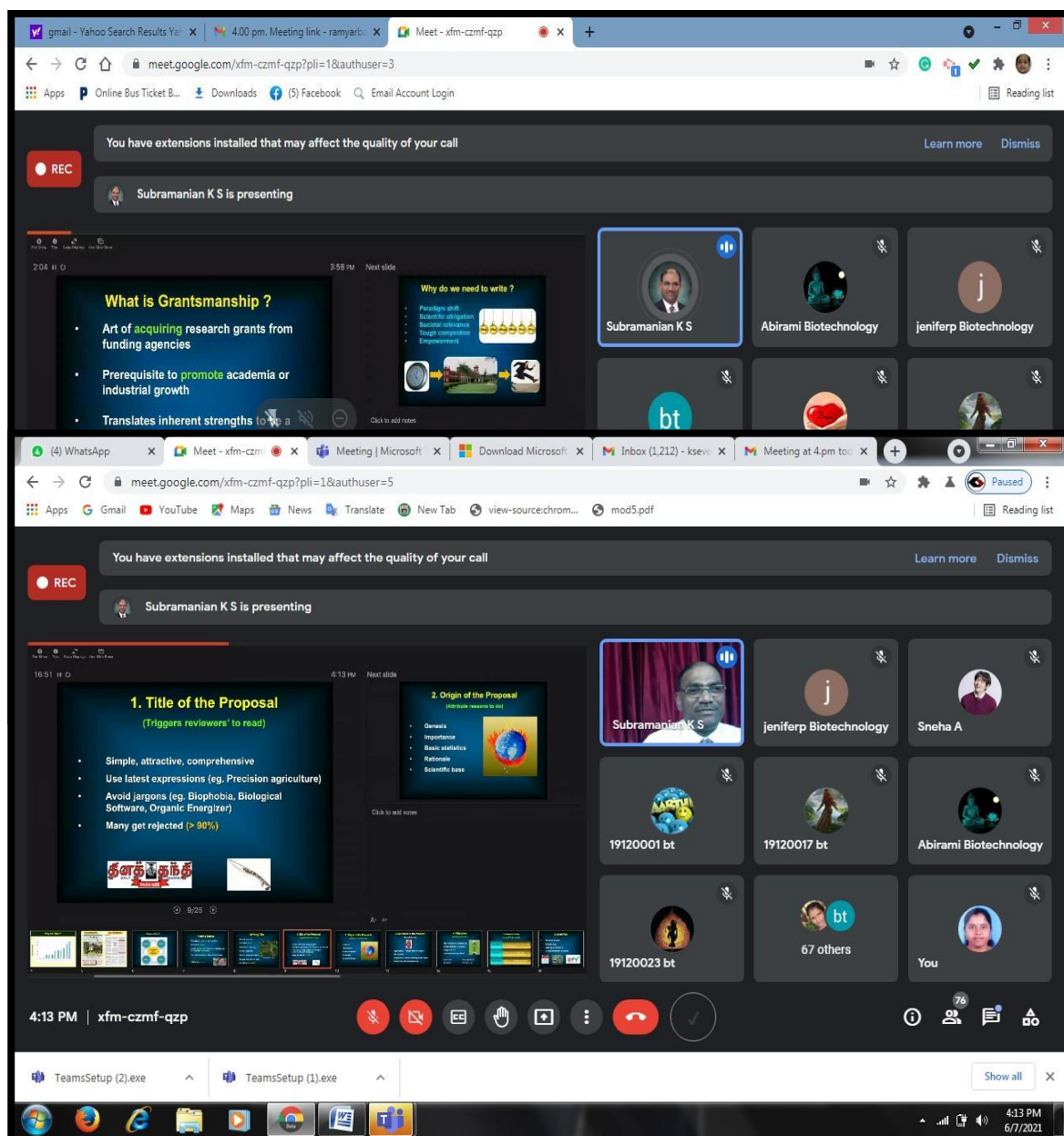

Navigating the intellectual space at the bottom and in the middle of the research ladder

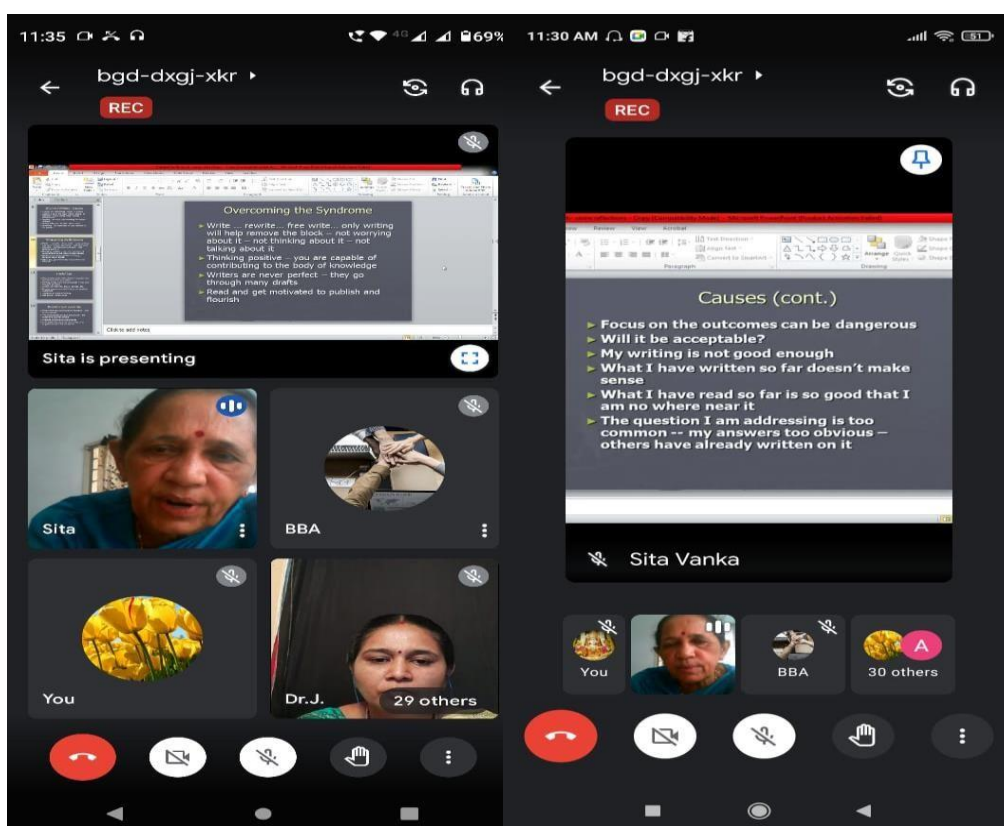

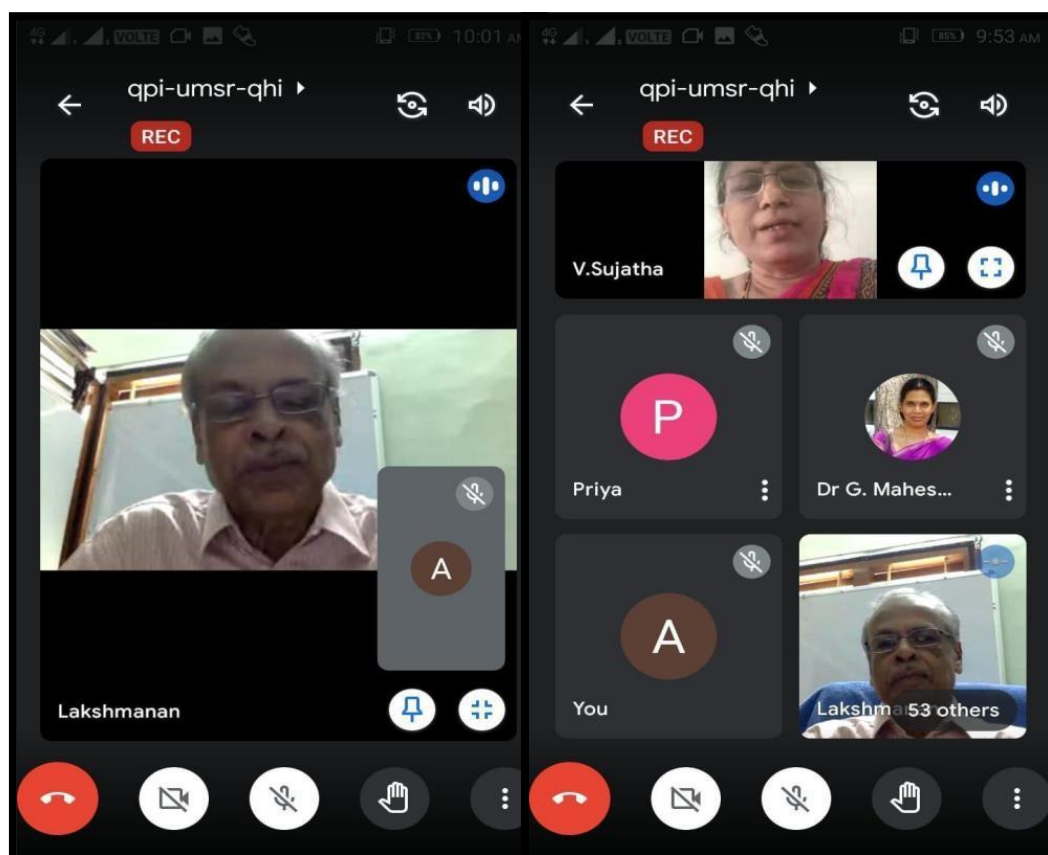
## DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

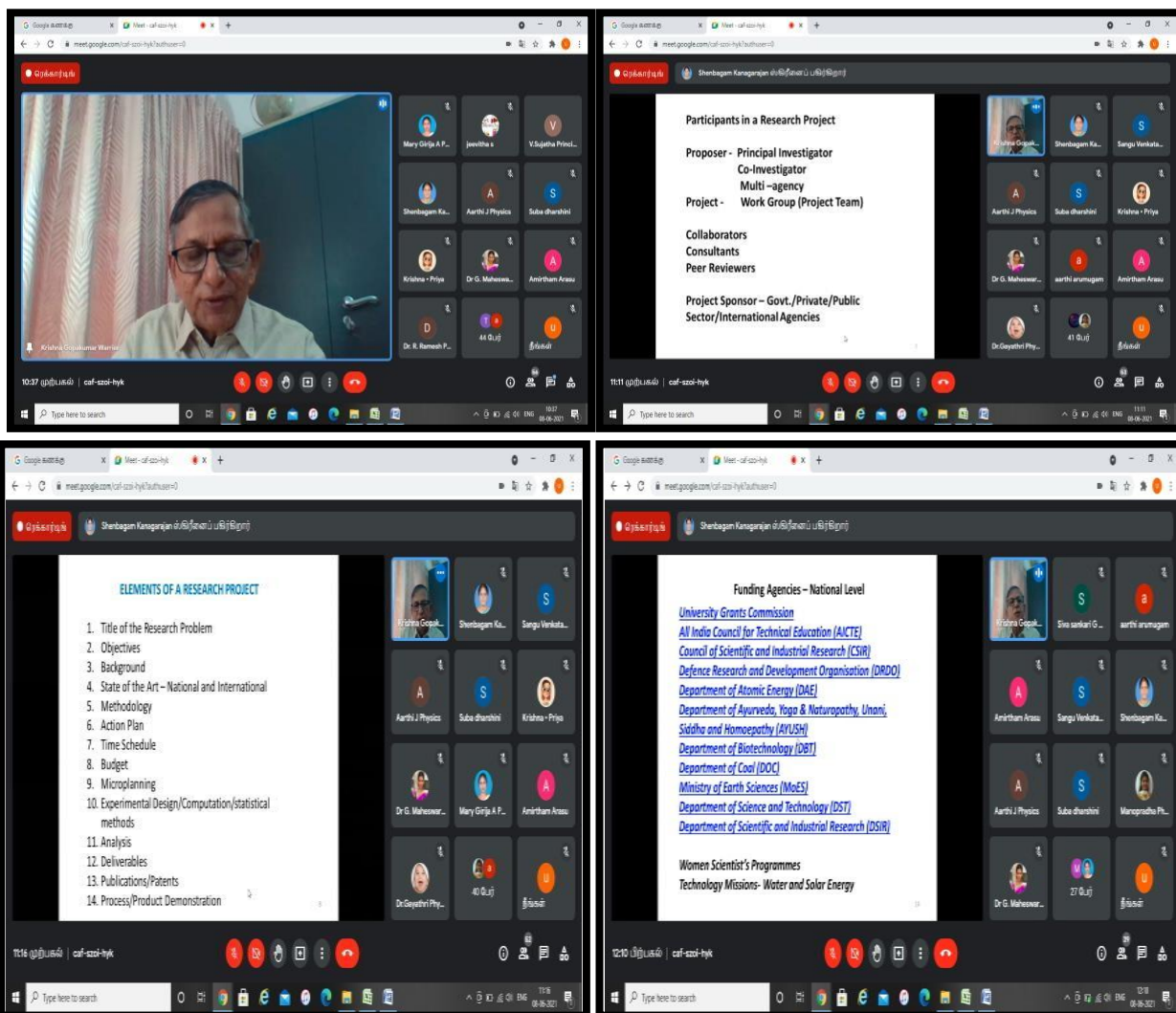
## DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

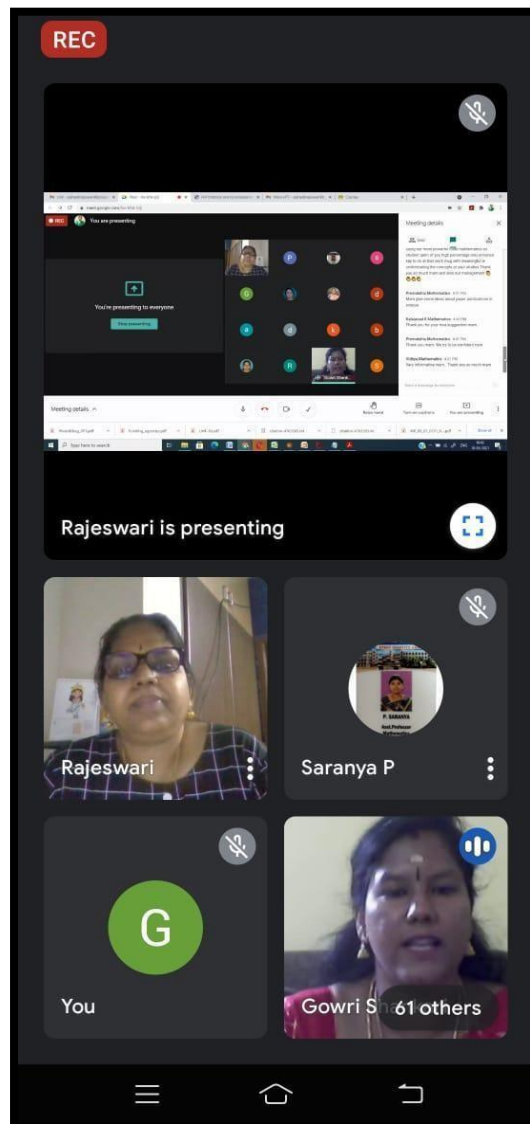

## DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS

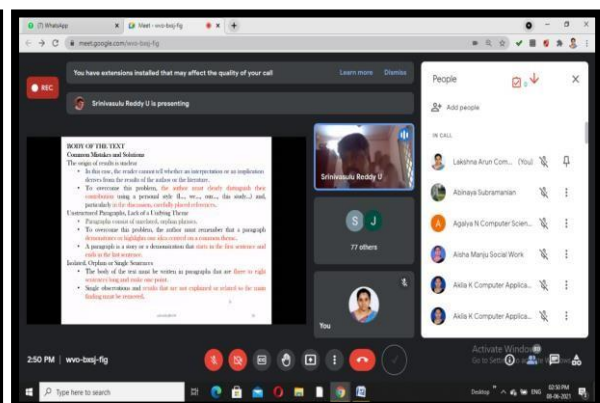
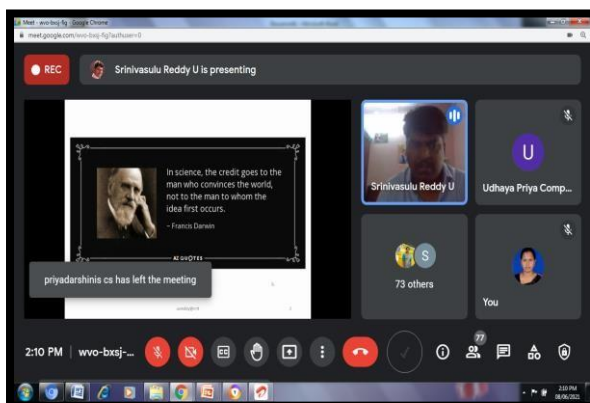
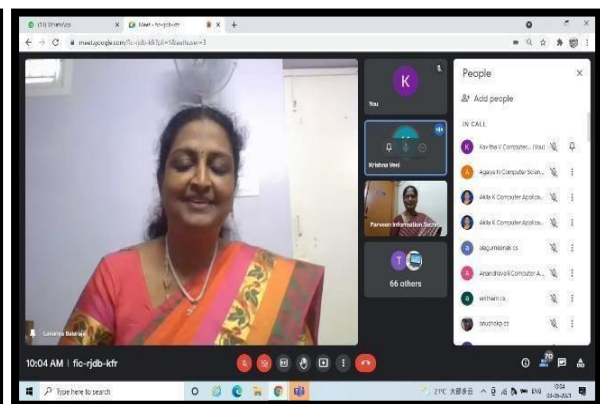
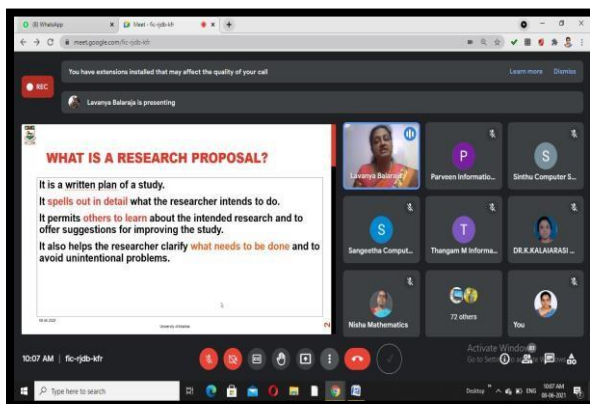

## DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY & COMPUTER APPLICATION.

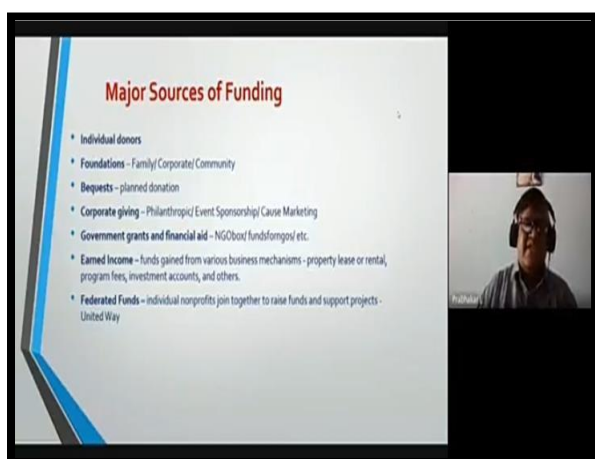

The second program on the “Tips and Best practices for writing a Scientific paper” was conducted between 02.00 PM to 03.30 PM. The resource person Dr. U.Srinivasulu Reddy Assistant Professor in the Department of Computer Applications, National Institute of Technology, Trichy has given a pervasive idea on how to write a quality scientific paper. The session specified the steps how to prepare a scientific paper for the budding research scholars and also for the experienced.

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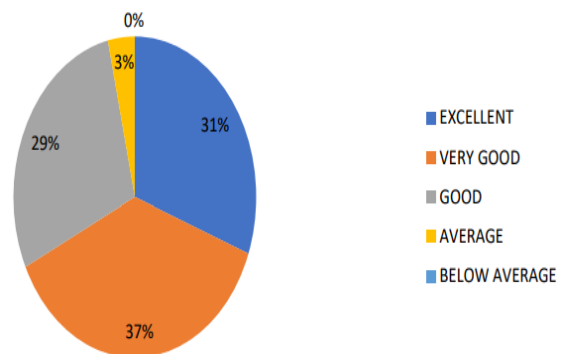
### FEEDBACK
