Initially the Chair Person welcomed all the members and the following measures were discussed.

Item No.1 Distribution of SC/ST Scholarships to the deserving students

Rs.4,62,104/- was claimed through Government SC/ST Fresh Scholarship for 82 students.

For 20 students, UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship were applied and Rs.2,28,000/- was claimed. Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) was applied for 23 and Rs.2,30,000/- was claimed. Minority scholarship has been applied for 38 students and Rs.2,28,000/- was claimed.

Item No.2 Renewal of Scholarship

Renewal of SC/ST scholarship for 182 students (Rs.11,54,790/-) were intimated through circular and class in-charges. For 14 students, renewal of UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship was initiated and a sum of Rs.4,34,000/- is claimed. Renewal of CSSS is applied for 54 students and Rs.5,40,000/- was claimed. Minority scholarship has been renewed for 32 students and Rs.1,92,000/- was claimed.

Item No.3 Special Schemes of Scholarship

Our management has magnanimously contributed 50% of the college fees Rs.6,68,750/- for 108 poor and needy UG & PG students, out of which 44 are II UG students, 51 are from III year UG students and 13 are II year PG students. Totally 108 students are the beneficiaries. 55% of II Term fees of Rs.27,940/- for 4 students and full term fees of Rs.25,000/- had been paid to 2 students by Mr. K. Rangarajan, founder of our college. From Palanisamy Pillai Trust Rs.6,250/- is sanctioned to one UG student.

Item No.4 Adequacy of Infrastructure Facilities

Sufficient infrastructure facilities such as Tri-Pods, Pen Tablet, Laptops had been added to the teachings aids, by our management, to handle the online classes effectively and to provide seamless teaching to the students. In addition to this 100 LCD projectors and 5 more Laptops are ordered to enhance ICT enabled teaching.

Item No.5 Career Guidance and Placement Cell

For all the final year students Career Guidance Training Programme were conducted to develop the skill sets for facing interviews and competitive exams with the support of GTT Training. SSC/IBPS and UPSC coaching are provided in collaboration with Bharathidasan University, Trichy.



Item No.6 Remedial action through Counseling Cell

To overcome the fear during the COVID Pandemic, counselling with regard to online class & examination, carrier counselling, anxiety, stress management, social media addiction, etc. are provided through trained Counselors.

Item No.7 Earn while Learn through ED cell

Fund generated by students during the lockdown Rs.23,090/- through supporting technical work, Bridal orders, Wedding decorative orders and Kids workshops. Total sales from Student Incubation Centre (SIC Bakes, Stores and Gallery) is Rs.4,40,089/- from Jan 2020 to till date.

Item No.8 Department Association Club

Department association clubs conducted various Webinar and Quizzes regarding COVID, as well as their own domain specific topics to inculcate knowledge and to motivate the students to take part in various competitions in and around virtually.

Item No.9 SWAYAM online Courses

II UG and II PG students registered NPTEL online course during Jun-Dec 2020 and many were successful in completing it. Meritorious students were recognized in order to motivate online learning. Fee waivers are applied for 188 students those who cleared the NPTEL exams.

Item No.10 Insistence of COVID Precautionary Measures

Students are constantly insisted and monitored to maintain social distance, wearing mask and sanitize their hands frequently. As a part of precautionary measure, COVID test were taken for 1,076 hostel students with the support of Corporation Health Center, Trichy. Mosquito spray and room sanitizing are done in a regular basis.
