Objectives: In accordance with the mutual desire to promote cooperation between Mentor Institute-CEDI NITT and Mentee Institute – CCW Parties are entering into a formal agreement in the form of MOU with the objective of promoting entrepreneurship.

The main objectives of the association are,

- Creating an Incubation support mechanism at Mentee institute
- 2. Building entrepreneurial culture at the institutional level
- 3. Promoting entrepreneurship amongst students, scholars, faculty, at institutional level
- 4. Identifying and selecting those who can be developed into entrepreneurs
- 5. Developing their entrepreneurial capabilities, domain & business skills
- Providing infrastructure and lab facility support to the identified startups subjected to further separate evaluation process and scrutiny under CEDI NITT Incubatee selection process

Following are the responsibilities of the Mentee Institute CCW: -

- to promote entrepreneurship among students, faculties, staff who are aspiring entrepreneurs, to set up their own businesses with the support of Mentor Institute.
- CCW can direct students, faculties, and staff after primary evaluation to Mentor Institute for further incubation guidance.
- iii. CCW can run event/ seminar/ workshop on entrepreneurship jointly either at CCW or at Mentor Institute as per mutual discussion and agreement before such event.
- CCW shall share their entrepreneurship related event details and activities with Mentor Institute community.
- v. CCW shall provide facility & lab support, if required by Mentor startups and will have separate effort and cost estimations, to be discussed and agreed between both the parties to the same.
- vi. CCW shall display Mentor Institute's Posters/Standees at their various entrepreneurship related joint events which will have both Mentor Institute and CCW logos.
- vii. CCW shall promote Mentor Institute by displaying Mentor Institute's name and logo on the CCW website.

Following are the general responsibilities of the Mentor Institute 'CEDI NITT': -

- Mentor Institute shall provide incubation and entrepreneurship development related support to CCW as a remote incubation center at their campus.
- b. Mentor Institute shall provide the basic mentoring with available internal resources to the students, faculty and staff from CCW subject to the idea evaluation under the suitable incubation module suggested by Mentor Institute.
- c. The incubatee at the Mentee Institute can be co-incubated at Mentor Institute, virtually or physically by paying nominal incubation charges. They can also use the facilities from time to time by paying nominal charges. Once, co-incubated, such incubatees would be eligible to apply for various schemes for grant or seed funding through Mentor Institute.
- Mentor Institute will also display CCW Posters/Standees at their various entrepreneurship related joint events which will have both Mentor Institute and CCW logos.
- Mentor Institute's events will be shared with CCW community.
- f. Mentor Institute shall promote CCW by displaying CCW name and logo on the Mentor Institute's website, as per usage policy communicated by Mentor institute from time to time.
- g. Mentor Institute and CCW shall follow Annexure 1 "Scope of Engagement" to get engaged in routine activities.

h. The substantial time and efforts beyond the activities mentioned in the Annexure 1 "Scope of Engagement" shall be estimated separately and mutually agreed by both the parties

Following are the terms and conditions of the agreement:

- 1. The term of this MOU shall commence on the 15th JUNE 2023 and shall continue until the expiry of 1 year i.e. 15th JUNE 2024 from the Effective Date. This agreement will have to be mutually renewed by both the Parties as per need basis. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.
- 2. In case, if any expenses and cost including travel, accommodation, honorarium gets involved for the different activities related to this MoU by the Mentor Institute, then such expenses and cost shall be borne by the mentee institute. Any exception to this clause would be based on prior written/email consent and mutual agreement of both the parties.

3. Confidentiality:

During the term of this Agreement, either party may disclose to the other party, or either party may obtain access to proprietary and confidential information or material concerning or related to the other party's and/or either party's customer's manufacturing processes, services, products, or operations. Such information or material includes, but is not limited to. general discoveries, inventions, research, improvements, or deficiencies regarding the parties' and/or customer's products or services, transactional profits, pricing and discount methods, employee lists, software code, programmer documentation, software algorithms, software development, testing and diagnostic techniques, customer lists and identifications, and any information designated or overtly treated by the party as ("Confidential Information"). However, Confidential Information shall not include any information which (a) is or becomes publicly known through no wrongful act or omission by the receiving party; (b) is known by a receiving party without any proprietary restrictions at the time of receipt of such Information from the disclosing party and/or customer; or (c) becomes rightfully known by a receiving party without proprietary restrictions from a source other than the disclosing party or customer (d) independently developed by the receiving party; or (e) approved by the disclosing party for release.

Either party acknowledges the confidential and proprietary character of the Confidential Information and agrees that the Confidential Information is the exclusive and valuable property of the disclosing party. Both the parties undertake to protect the Confidential Information with the same degree of care as it uses to protect its own Confidential Information. Accordingly, receiving party agrees not to reproduce any of the Information except as necessary to perform services hereunder, and not to divulge all or any part of the Confidential Information to any third party, either during or after the term of this Agreement.

The secrecy of the Confidential Information disclosed pursuant to this Agreement shall be maintained for a period of five (5) years following disclosure thereof. In case of breach, the affected party shall have the right to seek injunctive relief, which relief shall not exclude any other recourse provided by law.

4. Intellectual Property:

The parties agree that neither of them shall acquire by virtue of this Agreement or any agreement, any rights of ownership, right to use or any other interest, right or title of copyrights, patents, trade secrets, trade marks, or any other Intellectual Property rights owned by the other party and/or developed or created independently by other party during this Agreement, and nothing herein shall mean nor shall be construed to mean that they are at any time assigned, licensed or otherwise alienated to the other party, nor the other party shall be entitled to claim any right, title or interest therein, at any time.

Term & Termination:

This Agreement shall be valid for a period of "1 (One)" year from the date of signing of the Agreement by both the parties unless extended in writing by both the parties for such term as m be mutually agreed upon or unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement. A extension shall be done prior to thirty (30) days of the completion of the Agreement period. Eith party may, without any termination obligations and liability, terminate this Agreement for any reas by providing prior notice in writing of at least 30 (thirty) days to the other party.

Relationship Between the Parties:

This MoU is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint ventu partnership, or formal business organization of any kind, and the rights and obligations of the Part shall be only those expressly set forth herein. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to grant eith Party the right to make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other Party without the pr written consent of the other Party. At all times contemplated herein, Mentor Institute and <short nar of institution> shall remain independent entities, each responsible for its own employees.

Right of Refusal:

Both parties shall reserve the right to refuse to undertake an assignment/ perceived busine opportunity under the joint responsibility of this Agreement after citing appropriate reasons.

9. No Liability:

Neither Party shall be liable to the other for any damages, whether direct indirect, incident consequential or special damages arising out of the performance or non-performance of the ten hereunder except for the breach of confidentiality and Intellectual Property.

10. Participation in Similar Activities

CCW

This MOU is a non-exclusive partnership, in no way restricts Mentor Institute or KRIC-NECfro participating in similar activities with other public or private agencies, organizations, or individuals

11. Force Majeure:

Neither of the parties hereto shall be considered in default in performance under the MoU if su performance is prevented or delayed by events such as war, civil war (whether declared or not), or commotion, insurgency, hostilities, revolution, riots, strikes, lockouts, conflagrations, epidemi accident, fire, flood, droughts, pandemics, earthquake or any act of god or order of the Government or causes beyond the reasonable control of the party affected, provided notice in writing is give within ten days, failing which, within the shortest period, by party affected. Soon after the cause majeure has been removed, the party whose ability to perform its obligation has been affected st

From the date of occurrence of case of force majeure, the obligations of the party affected shall be suspended during the continuance of any inability resulting there from have been removed and the agreed time of completion of the respective obligations under this agreement shall stand extended by a period equal to the delay occasioned by such events. Should one or both parties be prevented from fulfilling the obligations by a state of Force Majeure lasting for a period of more than three (3) months, the parties shall consult each other and decide on the future execution of the MoU or/and the respective Project Agreement.

12. Extension or amendment of this MOU:

This MOU may be extended or amended only through by common written consent between the Parties. The decision to amend or extend the MOU, and language describing the agreed upon changes, shall be documented in writing, including the date of the amendment/extension, and the signatures of the authorised signatory of each Party.

13. Notices:

All notices, including notice of address change, required to be sent hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been delivered when mailed by first class mail or reputable courier service return receipt requested to the address stated in the first page of this MoU. Electronic communications are admissible provided these are sent with delivery confirmation receipt and followed by physical copy mailed as set forth above.

14. Publicity:

Both the Parties shall be entitled to issue or make any press releases or other public announcements relating to this MoU. However, all press releases or other public announcements relating to this MoU must be approved in advance and in writing, in each instance, by both the Parties.

15. Governing Law:

This MoU shall be construed, interpreted and governed by the laws of Republic of India & Courts /Tribunal having exclusive jurisdiction over Tiruchirappalli

16. Dispute Resolution:

Any disputes arising between the Parties regarding the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement or any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or any breach or alleged breach thereof, (Herein after referred to as the 'Dispute') both parties shall attempt to resolve the Dispute in good faith within the (30) days after either party informing the other party in writing of existence of such Dispute, failing which either party shall refer the dispute to arbitration conducted through mutually appointed sole arbitrator in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any amendments thereto. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in the English language. The arbitration proceedings shall be held at Tiruchirappalli, India. The parties shall share the cost of arbitration equally. The arbitration award shall be final and binding on both parties.

17. Severability:

If any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid in arbitration/in a court of law, the remaining provisions shall be construed as if the invalid provision was not included in this Agreement. The parties shall endeavor to replace such invalid provision with another provision which as far as legally possible reflects the original intent of the Parties.
