Minutes of the 3rd Meeting

Item No.1 Distribution of SC/ST Scholarships to the deserving students

Rs.5,71,880/- was sanctioned through Government SC/ST Fresh Scholarship for 86 students.

For 17 students, UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship and UGC Rank Holders Scholarship for a total amount of Rs.5,27,000/- has been sanctioned.

Item No.2 Renewal of Scholarship

Renewal of SC/ST scholarship for 203 students (Rs.14,17,830/-) is intimated through circular and class in-charges.

Item No.3 Special Schemes of Scholarship

Our management is magnanimously contributing college fees and hostel fees for the poor and needy students. Rs.12,89,850/- was paid by our college management as the II Term fees for both UG and PG out of which 56 - I year UG & PG students, 63 - II year UG & PG students and 43 -III year UG students totally 168 were benefited. 55% of II Term fees for 9 students Rs.77,220/and full term fess of Rs.62,400/- had been paid to 4 students by Mr. K.Rangarajan, founder of our college.

Item No.4 Adequacy of Infrastructure Facilities

Sufficient infrastructure facilities such as bus, canteen, and class room with proper ventilation, laboratory, toilets, Xerox and others are available for the students which are maintained regularly.

Item No.5 Career Guidance and Placement Cell

For all the final year students Career Guidance Training were conducted to enhance the students' ability with the support of GTT Training in collaboration with Capgemini, Trini-PI Technology Solns, Yaltech Global, EIT and Diksha Academy.

330 students were recruited by reputed companies and organization through On-Campus and Off-Campus.

Item No.6 Remedial action through Counseling Cell

Among the students various cases such as Adjustment, Absentees, relationship issues, family issues, scholastic backwardness, eating disorders etc., were identified and rectified through trained Counselors.

Item No.7 Afternoon lunch to deserving student by Leo Club

11 poor and needy students were provided with afternoon lunch through Leo Club which are shortlisted by the respective department Heads.

Item No.8 Rockcity Welfare Association Book Bank through Rotaract

Rotaract Club renders their helping hand by circulating books to the 39 deserving students every semester throughout their course completion and a total amount of Rs.15,000/- has been given to 2 students towards their semester fee.

Item No.9 Mentor - Mentee

Mentor-Mentee system is implemented with 1:20 ratio to advice, motivate and address the various issues of the students. During the pandemic period the syllabus has been completed through online mode for the betterment of students. The problematic students are taken care by the Counseling Cell.

Item No.10 & 11 Nutritious foods and Fee waiver for Sports and Cultural students

To encourage the Sports and Cultural students and to take part actively in various competitions, management is magnanimous enough to provide nutritious foods and fees concession.

Item No.12 Earn while Learn through ED cell

To develop the students entrepreneurial skills, hands on training programme has been conducted through online mode such as Training in Creative works, Coffee Painting, Don't stop Dreaming and entrepreneurship. Students had undergone various Internship programs to enhance their knowledge.

Item No.13 Department Association Club

Department association clubs are conducting various programme to inculcate knowledge and motivating the students to take part in various competitions in and around the colleges.

Item No.14 SWAYAM online Courses

I UG and I PG students were motivated to take at least one SWAYAM online course during the academic year 2019-2020

Item No.15 Grievances through College Union Office Bearers'

As per the grievances raised by the College Union Office Bearers' the requirements has been met out.
