Minutes of the 5th Meeting

Initially the Chairperson welcomed all the members and the following measures were discussed.

Item No.1 Distribution of SC/ST Scholarships to the deserving students

Rs.1,78,200/- was claimed through Government SC/ST Fresh Scholarship for 40 students.

For 8 students, UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship was applied and Rs.2,89,600/- was claimed. Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) was applied for 25 and Rs.2,50,000/- was claimed. Minority scholarship has been applied for 37 students and Rs.2,22,000/- was claimed.

Item No.2 Review of Renewal of Scholarship

Renewal of SC/ST scholarship for 164 students (Rs.10,08,774/-) were intimated through circular and class in-charges. For 53 students, renewal of UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship was initiated and a sum of Rs.5,30,000/- is claimed. Renewal of CSSS is applied for 54 students and Rs.5,40,000/- was claimed. Minority scholarship has been renewed for 34 students and Rs.2,04,000/- was claimed.

Item No.3 Review of Special Schemes of Scholarship

Our management has magnanimously contributed 50% of the college fees Rs.6,57,770/- for 87 poor and needy UG & PG students, out of which 38 are II UG students, 45 are from III year UG students and 04 are II year PG students.

Item No.4 Review of Adequacy of Infrastructure Facilities

To handle the online classes effectively and to provide seamless teaching to the students 48 LCD projectors and 50 Laptops are purchased and distributed to all the departments.

Item No.5 Review of Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Career Guidance and Placement Cell has signed a new MOU with Bajaj Finserv Ltd., & Bajaj Finance Ltd., Pune from 3rd March 2021 to 31st March 2024 for conducting the free Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance (CPBFI). 182 Students were benefited through the programme.

Life Skills Training Programme was organized through GTT for 500 students. Training on Medical Coding for 55 Life Science Students was given through EIT.

Arranged an Internship on e-content development (Video Making) with stipend at Class 21a Technologies Pvt. Ltd., (DoubtNut), Haryana.

Item No.6 Review of Remedial action through Counseling Cell

Students are counselled through trained counselors to use the electronic gadgets properly during online class. Reality Therapy was applied to the hostel students to cope with their situation effectively.



Item No.7 Fee Payment through online

Students are encouraged to pay their fees online during this pandemic and it reduces their waiting time for the fee payment.

Item No.8 Student Group Insurance

The annual premium of Rs.25 per year per student is collected compulsorily by clubbing it with other fees for the Student Group Insurance as per the instruction given by the Bharathidasan University.

Item No.9 Review of Skill Development through Rotaract

The Rotaract Club of Cauvery College has done many fellowships and can also focus on the development of young ones as leaders in their workspace. Due to covid, The Rotaractors of Cauvery College have done projects both online and offline such as Miss.APURVA(Personality Development Programme), Emerging Pillars(Soft Skill Development Programme) and Career Guidance Programme.

Item No.10 Review of Student Incubation Centre

Ms. Shrinidhi won TamilNadu Student innovators Challenge 2021 with a cash prize of Rs.1,00,000/- and also was awarded with Rs.10,000 cash from our college management as a token of appreciation

Entrepreneurship Development Cell offers 30 Skill development Courses to enhance entrepreneurial skill. Financial assistance of Rs.10,000/- was received to support 5 students for developing a live prototype in gathering automated data of the college bus commuters.

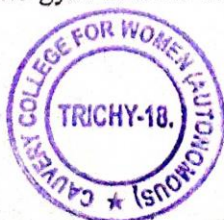
14 students and 2 alumni students availed the virtual hands-on training in Python Basic course. 3 students visited TABIF to discuss their innovative ideas. 36 students benefited in the Skill training programme given by CECRI- CSIR in Bio sensing application.24 students from various disciplines were given a communication skill assessment training programme to improve their personality traits along with communication skills.

Item No.11 Review of Department Association Club

Department association clubs conducted various Webinar and Quizzes on their own domain specific topics to inculcate knowledge and to motivate the students to take part in various competitions in and around virtually.

Item No.12 Cauvery Fitness Centre

The Cauvery Fitness Centre with 1250 sq.mtrs is equipped with elliptical machine, Spin machine, airfan, Ab bench, hyperextension, multi bench, double twister and five station multi gym. The students are allowed to access the gym in their allotted timings to practice a healthy lifestyle.



Item No.13 Review of WINGS Online Interdepartmental Competition

Even during pandemic, various online solo events are conducted for all the department students to exhibit their talents.

Item No.14 Review of SWAYAM online Courses

All the students are encouraged to enroll in the NPTEL online courses during June-Dec 2021 and many were successful in completing it. Free transport facility provided to the students to attend the NPTEL exam. Fee waivers are applied for 222 students who cleared the NPTEL exams during Jan-March 2021 batch. Online Soft Skills training was conducted for the students through NPTEL. Meritorious students are to be recognized in order to motivate online learning.

Item No.15 Review of Insistence of COVID Precautionary Measures

As per the norms and Instructions of the Government of Tamilnadu, various initiatives are done to keep the premises clean and hygiene due to the persisting pandemic situation. In addition the hostel students are asked to use sanitizers regularly monitored regarding temperature and the pulse rate is also checked using the Oximeter. The floors are sanitized regularly. Almost 300 hostel students and more number of day scholar students are vaccinated in the campus in collaboration with Tiruchirappalli Corporation. Students are constantly insisted and monitored to maintain social distance, wearing masks and sanitizing their hands frequently. RTPCR Tests are also conducted for the students bimonthly. Mosquito spray and room sanitizing are done on a regular basis.

New Item no.16:

Merit cum Means Scholarship

During the meeting it was informed to the Committee Members that the poor and needy students to be identified with good marks to provide the fee concession for semester fees.

The Chairperson also desired that the students in collaboration with Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the Institution should make all our effort to achieve maximum placement in the reputed companies/Organization.



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
