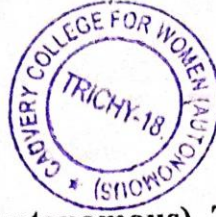

Minutes of the 7th Meeting

Initially the Chairperson welcomed all the members and the following measures were discussed.

Item No.1 Distribution of SC/ST Scholarships to the deserving students

Government SC/ST Scholarship for 15 students are applied for the students admitted in the academic year 2022-2023.

For 10 students, UGC Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Single Girl Child Scholarship is applied and Rs.2,36,000/- was claimed. Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) was applied for 24 students and Rs.2,40,000/- was claimed. Govt. Minority Scholarship of Rs.1,62,000/- has been applied for 27 students. Redington scholarship is applied for 10 students for the total sum of Rs.1,00,000/-. Government Moovalur Scholarship is approved for 178 students and received Rs.1000/- for each student.

Item No.2 Review of Renewal of Scholarship

Renewal of SC/ST scholarship for 126 students were intimated through circular and class in-charges. Renewal of Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) is done for 150 students and Rs.15,40,000/- was claimed. For 30 students Minority scholarship has been renewed and Rs.1,80,000/- was claimed. Redington scholarship is also renewed for 11 students and Rs.1,10,000/- was claimed.

Item No.3 Review of Special Schemes of Scholarship by Management

Our management has magnanimously contributed the college fees of Rs.4,90,700/- for 61 poor and needy II UG & II PG students. 39 Students from III UG are benefitted through the management scholarship of Rs. 3,10,200/-.

Item No.4 Review of Career Guidance and Placement Cell

1. Career Guidance and Placement Cell has organized an online training program on “Digital Job Skills Course from Job Life Joy”. Totally 490 students got benefitted. By the motivation given during the training 349 students undergone the courses “Digital 101 Journey” on “Future Skills” and got the certificate successfully which was conducted by Future Skills in alliance with NASSCOM.

2. An orientation program about free training on “Soft Skills” was organized and oriented by Mrs. P. Subha, Sr. Executive, Hiring & Recruitment, Global Talent Track Pvt. Ltd., Trichy.

3. Aptitude Training was given by Mr. Jaganath, Founder, Mithra Knowledge Hub and Mr. Pratheep. Totally 114 students from various departments are benefitted through this training.

RECRUITMENT DETAILS.

For this academic year, the passed out students have been given the chances to attend different on-line interviews. Till date, 10 of our passed out students are placed in different companies like Infosys, TCS, Capgemini, Vee Technologies, Focus Edumatics Pvt. Ltd., and Tachyon Pvt. Ltd.,(Zullu Computation), Bangalore.

Item No.5 Review of Counselling Cell

Counseling Cell of Department of Social Work continually addresses the problems of students who seek professional assistance. The problems encountered by the students are deviant behaviors, lack of attention during class, conflict with classmates, deviated and became addicted to social media and lost the practice of reading, memorizing & attending tests and lack of interest in their studies. Reality oriented session were given to bring them back to study. To rectify this Parent-Teachers meeting was organized, continuous follow up was done.

Item No.6 Review of Student Group Insurance

The annual premium of Rs.25 per year per student is collected compulsorily by clubbing it with other fees for the Student Group Insurance as per the instruction given by the Bharathidasan University.

Item No.7 Review of Student Incubation Centre

E Cell has established Student Incubation Center (SIC) with a motto to create an entrepreneurial eco - system during their graduation period. 12 students are monitoring the campus companies incorporated under SIC.

Ms.Dhaarani, Student Alumni, Commerce is approved with PMEGP loan of Rs.2,00,000/- to start an alumni campus company of Herbal Sanitary Napkin unit inside the campus and has employed an alumni of our college with a monthly salary of Rs.1000. The entrepreneurship Development Cell jointly with RAISE has set up Centre of Excellence with an investment of Rs.50,000/- towards the purchase of IoT and Robotic tools for the welfare of students process of ideation to prototypes. Rs. 7,060/- was earned by our students through utilizing the various facilities available at SIC. 4 alumni's are given opportunity to take value added course for the students and earned Rs.32,636/-. 32 students from various disciplines have earned a cumulative revenue of Rs.3875.

Item No.8 Review of Department Association Club

Department association clubs conducted various Conferences, Seminars, Workshops and Quizzes on their own domain specific topics to inculcate knowledge and also to motivate the students to take part in various competitions.

Item No.9 Review of Cauvery Fitness Centre

The Cauvery Fitness Centre is newly equipped with a Treadmill of Rs. 2,00,000/- worth during this semester. The students are allowed to access the gym in their allotted timings to practice a healthy lifestyle.

Item No.10 Review of Rotaract Club

Rotary club of Tiruchirappalli, midtown has contributed Rs 17,770/- to pay the semester fee and 1 student got benefitted. Rockcity Weelfare Association(RWA) has issued free books for 33 students.

Item No.11 Review of Leo Club

Lions Club of Tiruchirappalli Rock city have sponsored Rs 10,000/- to Leo club of Cauvery College for Women. This amount is utilized to provide noon meal to the economically weaker students. Under noon meal scheme 13 deserving students from all the department were selected and having their noon meal at hostel.

Item No.12 Review of SWAYAM online Courses

Students are encouraged to enroll in the NPTEL online courses every semester and free transport facility is provided to the students to attend the NPTEL exam. Fee waivers are applied and approved for 206 students who cleared the NPTEL exams during Jan – April 2022.

To recognize and appreciate the meritorious students and to motivate online learning, our management has magnanimously reimbursed the exam fees of Rs.1000/- to the students qualified with Toppers, Elite+Gold and Elite+Silver grade. Rs.25,000/- was given by Rajagopal Trust and Rs. 43,000/- was refunded by our management. Totally 68 students were recognized.

Item no.13 Review of Merit cum Means Scholarship

Under Merit cum Means Scholarship for II UG and III UG the poor and needy students with good marks were identified and fee concession of Rs.1,35,000/- was given for the semester fees. From Prof. Srinivasan Trust, Rs. 30,000/- were received and two poor and needy students' semester fee was paid.

Item no.14 Financial Assistance given by Management

Thiru. Thiruneelakandan, Secretary has deposited Rs.50,000/- and the interest amount Rs.5000/- is provided B.Com students.
