 in person to find a solution through collaborative efforts. Students who need counselling
 can be referred to the counselling center functioning in the college.
- To alleviate the problem of stealing or missing of students' belongings especially mobile phones during examinations, students are asked to keep their bags inside the exam hall or in the places under CCTV surveillance.
- To have parent-teachers meetings at regular intervals in order to understand the students in a better way by the parents and teachers.
- 4. Students who drop out from college in the first semester are to be refunded their semester fee as per UGC guidelines based on their request made in writing. The college has refunded the semester fee for over 50 students in the academic year 2021-2022.
