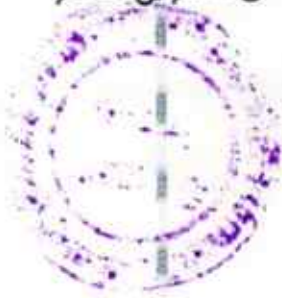

Article 1: Purpose

By signing this Memorandum, both parties hereby confirm their intention to collaborate or conduct the following activities so as to enhance their educational, entrepreneurship/startups development activities and industrial research in the fields of life sciences, engineering and technologies:

- (1) Development of a mutual understanding of shared issues and interests of the researchers and educators of both parties;
- (2) Exploration of opportunities for development and execution of collaborative research projects and innovative products.
- (3) Exchange of information and materials in those fields, which are of interest to both parties;
- (4) Exchange of appropriate trainings to the personals involved in both parties;
- (5) Utilization of laboratory facilities of both organizations for mutual benefits as per the regulation;
- (6) Exchange of research, technical and business support from both parties;
- (7) Conducting joint workshops and semiars etc.;
- (8) Organization of academic/industrial meetings, pertaining thereto;

Article 2: Mode of collaboration

Matters pertaining to the implementation of the activities based on this agreement shall be negotiated and agreed upon between both parties concerned in each specific case, and may be stipulated in writing as memorandums complimentary to this agreement.

Article 3: Confidentiality

Subject to further agreements to be negotiated, as detailed in Article 2, each party acknowledges the principles of confidentiality and that both parties will treat any confidential information including, but not limited to, proprietary information, trade secrets, and personal information of individuals, received from the other party as confidential and not to disclose such information to any third party. Furthermore, each party will only use such information in connection with this MoU.

Article 4: Duration

This agreement shall become effective on the date of its signing by the representative of both parties and shall be in force for three years.

Article 5: Termination

Either party may, by giving six months' written notice to the other party, terminate the agreement. However, the termination of this agreement shall not affect the implementation of the collaborative project activities established under it prior to such termination.

Article 6: Renewal

In the absence of any such early termination, the renewal of this agreement shall be discussed by the two parties no less than six months prior to the natural termination of the current agreement.

Article 7: Coordinators

Each party shall designate contact person(s), who are authorized to represent his respective organization in formal negotiation or renegotiation of this MoU. Either party may change its designated contact person by written notification to the designated contact person of the other party.

Article 8: Intellectual Property Rights

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative project activities under the agreement will be worked out on case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two organizations.
