ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Government / University Grants Commission (UGC), regulation notified vide no F.1-74/2016(ARC) dated on 05-07-2023 on curbing Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2023 (under section 26(1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act,1956) are strictly implemented at our institution.

According to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts which may cause or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.

POLICY:

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college campus. The main objectives of this cell are as follows:

- To make the students aware of the dehumanizing effect of ragging inherent in its perversity
- ❖ To keep vigilant over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence
- * To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to our notice
- To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

PRACTICES:

As per the order of Supreme Court of India subsequent notification from the University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- ✓ Any act of indiscipline, teasing or handling others with rudeness
- ✓ Any act that prevents, disrupts the regular academic activity
- ✓ Any activity which is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, psychological harm or creates fear or apprehension

- ✓ Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure
- ✓ Any act of physical abuse causing assault, harm or danger to health
- ✓ Any act of vertical abuse, emails, SMS or public insult etc...
- ✓ Warning, writing apology letter.

INSTITUTIONAL MEASURES

This institution does not encourage any form of ragging and follow zero tolerance for ragging.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established, the possible punishments for those who found guilty of ragging shall be punished with anyone /combination of the following:-

- ⊗ Cancellation of admission
- ⊗ Suspension
- ⊗ With holding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- ⊗ Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- ⊗ With holding results
- ⊗ Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

- ✓ Seniors welcome their juniors with open arms
- ✓ Seniors are ready to help the freshers
- ✓ There is no sense of fear in freshers when they come to college
