## Item No.6 Review of Counselling Cell

Counseling Cell of Department of Social Work continually addresses the problems of students who seek professional assistance. The problems of students encountered was low academic performance, mobile addiction, family relationship, single parent child relationship, love affair. Reality therapy was applied to the students to come out of their problems and also contacted parents of few students and offered tele counselling. 8 cases were received this academic year and the problems were redressed between 1 to 3 sessions.

#### Item No.7 Review of Department Association Club

Department association clubs conducted various Conferences, Seminars, Workshops and Quizzes on their own domain specific topics to inculcate knowledge and also to motivate the students to take part in various competitions. Additionally, they arranged diverse extension activities aimed at instilling a sense of social responsibility in students, who actively engaged in these initiatives. Students enthusiastically engage in student clubs and organizations, actively volunteering for community service projects and pursuing internships and research opportunities. Student alumnae were invited as resource person to deliver motivational speech and career guidance tips.

#### **Item No.8 Review of Sports**

#### **College Fee:**

1.Ms.S.Abarna Shree of I-N&D was awarded a scholarship of ₹17,000/- for the second semester, approved on 22.01.25, in recognition of her selection to represent Bharathidasan University at the South Zone All India Inter-University Yoga Tournament held at KIIT University, Odisha.

2. Ms.B.Nishanthi of I-B.Com was awarded a scholarship of ₹17,000/- for the second semester, approved on 22.01.25, in recognition of her being selected to represent Bharathidasan University in the South Zone All India Inter-University Fencing Tournament at Jammu.

#### Honorarium for Sports Discipline Students:

The Appreciation Amount for the College Discipline Committee students for their hard work in maintaining strict discipline throughout the year, for checking bus pass and enabling the students to

follow Discipline, is a cash amount of ₹1000/-each to the 27 volunteers of the Discipline Committee for rendering their services to the institution for the academic year 2024-2025.

### Item No.9 Review of Leo Club

Lions Club of Tiruchirappalli Rock city have sponsored ₹11,000/- for noon meal scheme and the deserving students from the departments were selected and having their noon meal at hostel.

## Item No.10 Review of Rotaract Club

Rotory Club of Tiruchirappalli midtown has contributed ₹15,000/- towards a student's semester fee. Additionally, Rockcity Welfare Association (RWA) has issued free books for 40 students through book bank scheme. Several events, including Personality Development Programme and an Awareness Session on Cervical Cancer were also conducted for the students.

#### Item No.11 Review of SWAYAM online Courses

Students are encouraged to enroll in the NPTEL online courses every semester and free transport facility is provided to the students to attend the NPTEL exam. Fee waivers are applied for 41 students who cleared the NPTEL exams and received ₹500/- for each student totally ₹20,500/- from NPTEL for the Jan-April 2024 and June-Dec 2024 semesters.

#### Item No.12 Review of Merit cum Means Scholarship

Under Merit cum Means Scholarship, 161 students of UG students with good marks were identified and fee concession of ₹8,05,000/- was given for the semester fees. Through the Cauvery College Alumna Association (CCAA), 135 students of I, II- and III-year students of UG were paid 50% of the even semester term fees of ₹6,75,000/-.

# Item No.13 Financial Assistance for Semester fees given by various trust

- From Prof. Srinivasan Trust, ₹1,72,500/- were received and 16 student's semester fee was paid.
- Through Palanisamy Pillai Trust ₹56,725/- was paid towards the term fees for 8 UG students.

- Mr. G. Muthukrishnan, College Joint Secretary has paid the semester fees of ₹62,475/- to 4 students.

- During convocation, the Overall Topper from UG Arts and UG Science students are awarded a cash prize of ₹20,000/- with plaque through "PURUSHOTHAMA REDDIAR" and "SHANTHI VIJAYARAGHAVAN" scholastic merit awards, respectively, for the 2024 batch students.
- Through Na. Subbu Reddiar Trust, each ₹5,000/- is given to the top students of Arts, Science and Commerce totalling ₹15,000/-
- To appreciate meritorious students and to motivate online learning through SWAYAM-NPTEL, our management reimbursed the exam fees of ₹31,000/- to 31 students for the Jan-May 2024 and June-Dec 2024 periods, who qualified with Toppers, Elite+Gold and Elite+Silver grade.
