
CIRCULAR

Initially the Chairperson welcomed all the members and the following measures were discussed.

Item No.1 Distribution of SC/ST Scholarships to the deserving students

Government SC/ST Scholarship are applied for the 127 students admitted in the academic year 2025-2026 and claimed ₹8,33,250/-

For 45 students, National Scholarship for Post Graduate Studies Scholarship was applied and ₹67,50,000/- was claimed. Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) was applied for 85 students and ₹10,20,000/- was claimed. For the 663 students, Moovalur Scholarship is applied and students are receiving ₹1000/- per month. GRT Scholarship given to 1 student for the amount ₹24,000/-

Item No.2 Review of Renewal of Scholarship

Renewal of SC/ST scholarship for 151 students were intimated through circular and class in-charges and received ₹9,23,300/-. For 9 students, National Scholarship for Post Graduate Studies Scholarship was applied and ₹13,50,000/- was claimed Renewal of Central Sector Scholarship Scheme (CSSS) is done for 149 students and ₹19,88,000/- was claimed.

Item No.3 Review of Special Schemes of Scholarship by Management

Our management has magnanimously contributed the 50% of the semester fees of ₹21,44,350/- to the poor and needy students. 120 UG students and 17 PG students were benefited.

Item No.4 Review of Student Incubation Centre

Ms. M. Sowmiya has been regularly receiving orders for the "Cauvery Millets" startup both within and outside the campus from June 2025 to date, earning Rs. 30,000/-. Ms. Akhila has also been handling regular orders for her startup "Munchy Pasta" within and outside the campus since June 2025, earning Rs. 3,000/-. Ms. Kathika Sri and Ms. N.K. Janani have been undertaking regular orders for the startup "Just Krytals" from September 2025 to date, earning Rs. 2,000/-.

Ms. Lathisha Parveen secured the Runner-up position at the Mole Hackathon conducted by Indra Ganesan College of Engineering and received a cash prize of Rs. 5,000/-.

Ms. Dhanya Shree V won the Fintech Hackathon organized by Bishop Heber College and was awarded Rs. 5,000/-.



In the area of intellectual property achievements, Ms. M. Sowmiya obtained trademark protection for “Cauvery Millets” in December 2025, while Ms. Akhila secured a design patent for “Munchy Pasta” in December 2025.

Ms. Catherin P and Ms. Chandraleka were nominated for YUKTHI and the IIT E-Summit, representing our HEI as office bearers under EDD 2025 at IIT Madras, during December 2025 and from February 6–8, 2026.

Ms. Karthika Sri A and Ms. Janani N.K. achieved the Runner-up position in FINETECH '26 organized by St. Joseph's College and also secured Runner-up at HERMA 2K26 conducted by SRC College in February 2026. They further participated in the E-Cell IITM E-Summit 2026 as office bearers representing our HEI under EDD 2025 at IIT Madras from February 6–8, 2026.

Additionally, Ms. Keerthana K, Ms. Dhanya Sri G, Ms. Sudharsanaa D, and Ms. Vinobala H also represented our HEI as office bearers under EDD 2025 at the E-Cell IITM E-Summit 2026 held at IIT Madras from February 6–8, 2026.

Item No.5 Review of Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Career Guidance and Placement Cell

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell made substantial progress during the academic year 2025–2026 through well-structured training programmes, industry collaborations, and career-oriented initiatives. MoUs were established with reputed organizations such as Bajaj Finserv Ltd., Global Talent Track Ltd., Effulgenz Informatics and Technotainments, Magic Bus, and Ethnus Consultancy Services Private Limited to provide training in banking, life skills, medical coding, and IT-ITeS domains. A total of 7 placement awareness programmes and 8 training programmes were conducted, benefiting many students. Key initiatives included CPBFI training, Global Talent Track life skills programmes, Magic Bus–IBM skill development training, and AI Skilled Passport programme.

Recruitment Details

The placement achievements for the academic year 2025-2026 reflect the effectiveness of these initiatives, with around 1,600 offer letters received and 700 students successfully placed during the academic year, with participation from more than 40 recruiters.

The wide range of companies from diverse sectors such as IT, manufacturing, banking, healthcare, education, and service industries highlights the institution's strong industry linkage and the adaptability of our students.



Item No.6 Review of Counselling Cell

Counseling Cell of Department of Social Work continually addresses the problems of students who seek professional assistance. The problems of students encountered was family and psychiatry issues, suicide attempt, love affair, and absenteeism. Reality therapy was applied to the students to come out of their problems and also contacted parents of few students and offered tele counselling. 5 cases were received this academic year and the problems were redressed between 1 to 3 sessions.

Item No.7 Review of Department Association Club

Department association clubs conducted various Conferences, Seminars, Workshops and Quizzes on their own domain specific topics to inculcate knowledge and also to motivate the students to take part in various competitions. Additionally, they arranged diverse extension activities aimed at instilling a sense of social responsibility in students, who actively engaged in these initiatives. Students enthusiastically engage in student clubs and organizations, actively volunteering for community service projects and pursuing internships and research opportunities. Student alumnae were invited as resource person to deliver motivational speech and career guidance tips.

Item No.8 Review of Sports

College Fee:

1. Ms.S. Abarna Shree of II N&D was awarded a scholarship of ₹36,200/- for the odd and even semester, in recognition of her participation in State Level Yoga Championship 2025 organized by TAPAS Yogalaya in association with Indian Yoga Association and won the First prize.

2. Ms. A. Asin of III B. Com was awarded a scholarship of ₹18,800/- for the sixth semester, in recognition of her participation in BALL BADMITON in the ALL INDIA INTER-UNIVERSITY TOURNAMENT 2025 organized by ALAGAPPA UNIVERSITY, KARAIKUDI.

Honorarium for Sports Discipline Students:

The Appreciation Amount for the College Discipline Committee students for their hard work in maintaining strict discipline throughout the year, for checking bus pass and enabling the students to follow Discipline, is a cash amount of ₹1000/-each to the 20 volunteers, total Rs.20,000/- of the Discipline Committee for rendering their services to the institution for the academic year 2025-2026.



Item No.9 Review of Leo Club

Lions Club of Tiruchirappalli Rock city has sponsored ₹10,000/- for noon meal scheme and the 6 deserving students from various departments were selected and having their noon meal at hostel.

Item No.10 Review of Rotaract Club

Rockcity Welfare Association (RWA) has issued free books for 28 students through book bank scheme. Several events, including Personality Development Programme and an Awareness Session on Cancer were also conducted for the students.

Item No.11 Review of SWAYAM online Courses

Students are encouraged to enroll in the NPTEL online courses every semester and free transport facility is provided to the students to attend the NPTEL exam. Fee waivers are applied for 52 students who cleared the NPTEL exams and received ₹500/- for each student totally ₹26,000/- from NPTEL for the Jan-April 2025 and June-Dec 2025 semesters.

Item No.12 Review of Merit cum Means Scholarship

Under Merit cum Means Scholarship, 101 students of UG students with good marks were identified and fee concession of ₹9,00,000/- was given for the semester fees. Through the Cauvery College Alumna Association (CCAA), 96 students of I, II-year and III-year students of UG were paid 50% of the even semester term fees of ₹4,80,000/-.

Item No.13 Financial Assistance for Semester fees given by various trust

- From Prof. Srinivasan Trust, ₹ 1,40,000 /- were received and 14 student's semester fee was paid.
- Through Palanisamy Pillai Trust ₹28,550/- was paid towards the term fees for 3 UG students.
- Three toppers from Department of Commerce received ₹6000/- from Sultan Chand Droupati Devi Memorial Scholarship
- Mr.N. Muthukrishnan, College President has paid the semester fees of ₹29,550/- to 3 students.
- AKS. Dr. K. Srinivasan, Srirangam has paid ₹1,85,250/- to 10 students

- During convocation, the Overall Topper from UG Arts and UG Science students are awarded a cash prize of ₹20,000/- with plaque through "PURUSHOTHAMA REDDIAR" and "SHANTHI VIJAYARAGHAVAN" scholastic merit awards, respectively, for the 2025 batch students.
- Our college management recognized the University Rank Holders with the cash prize of ₹1000/- for the I rank and ₹500/- for other rank holders. 21 students are recognized with the total sum of ₹11,000/- including one University First Rank.
- Through Na. Subbu Reddiar Trust, each ₹5,000/- is given to the top students of Arts, Science and Commerce totalling ₹15,000/-
- Students who got highest mark in Part I Tamil are recognized with cash award of Rs.1000/- and highest mark in the II year and III year Department of Tamil students received Rs.1000/- and Rs.500/- from Krishna Sweets
