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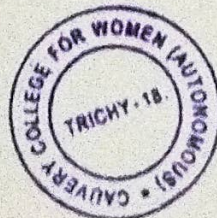
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Background

Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy and FINSPIRE Academy Private Limited, Chennai share a common vision of enhancing student employability and preparing graduates for emerging opportunities in the global business environment. The Parties propose to collaborate in creating structured academic pathways that may integrate globally recognised professional qualifications, including but not limited to US CMA, US CPA, CIA, CISA, CFA and other internationally recognised credentials, together with future-ready skills, industry engagement and employability initiatives, as may be mutually agreed from time to time. The present collaboration shall initially relate only to the US CMA programme. Future initiatives, if any, shall be undertaken through mutually agreed schedules or separate agreements.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) records the broad policy framework governing the strategic academic collaboration between Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous) ('College') and FINSPIRE Academy Private Limited ('FINSPIRE'). It establishes the principles, responsibilities and governance framework of the collaboration. Operational modalities may be documented separately through mutually agreed schedules.

Purpose

To collaborate in creating future-ready graduates through globally recognised professional qualifications, future-ready skills, employability initiatives, industry engagement and other mutually agreed academic interventions.

Scope of Collaboration

The Parties may collaborate in professional certification pathways, future-ready skills, employability initiatives, faculty development, industry engagement, international collaborations and other academic initiatives consistent with the objectives of this MOU, as may be mutually agreed from time to time.

Roles of FINSPIRE

FINSPIRE shall be responsible for the academic design, delivery, faculty, mentoring, assessments, learning resources, student support, programme administration and such other responsibilities as may be agreed for the initiatives undertaken under this MOU.

Roles of the College

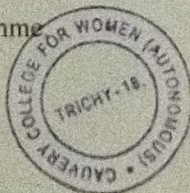
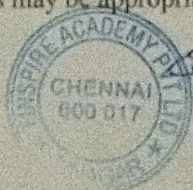
The College shall facilitate institutional coordination, institutional approvals, student coordination, infrastructure and administrative support, and such other assistance as may be mutually agreed.

Learning Resources

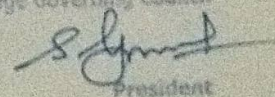
FINSPIRE shall provide appropriate learning resources, including licensed software platforms where applicable, digital learning materials, structured assessments, recorded academic sessions and other academic resources considered necessary for effective programme delivery.

Student Support

FINSPIRE shall establish an appropriate student support framework comprising mentoring, progress monitoring, assessment feedback, doubt clarification and communication with students and parents, as may be appropriate for the programme.

Governance

The Parties shall establish appropriate coordination mechanisms to periodically review implementation, address operational matters, maintain academic quality and student experience, and explore opportunities for continuous improvement and future collaboration. The Parties may designate appropriate representatives as Single Points of Contact (SPOCs) for effective implementation and coordination.

Commercial Terms

The commercial terms governing this collaboration are set out in Annexure A, **as may be amended by mutual written agreement from time to time**, and shall form an integral part of this MOU.

Operational Framework

The Operational Framework governing implementation of this collaboration is set out in Annexure B, **as may be amended by mutual written agreement from time to time**, and shall form an integral part of this MOU.

Intellectual Property

Each Party shall retain ownership of its respective intellectual property. Neither Party shall acquire any ownership rights in the intellectual property of the other except as expressly agreed in writing.

Branding

Use of names, logos and brand identities shall be only for activities connected with this collaboration and subject to mutual approval.

Confidentiality

Both Parties shall maintain confidentiality of proprietary, academic and commercial information exchanged under this MOU except where disclosure is required by law.

Term

This MOU shall remain valid for an initial period of three years and may be renewed by mutual written consent.

Termination

Either Party may terminate this MOU for material breach after providing a reasonable opportunity to cure. Termination shall not adversely affect students already enrolled and both Parties shall cooperate to ensure completion of commitments to such students.

Force Majeure

Neither Party shall be liable for failure to perform due to events beyond its reasonable control.

Governing Law

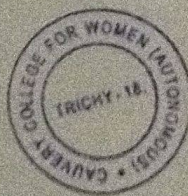
This MOU shall be governed by the laws of India and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Trichy.

This MOU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties regarding the policy framework of the collaboration.

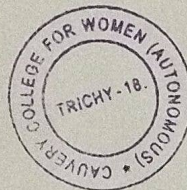

Only students admitted under the current second year batch shall give a PDC dt. 1st April 2028 for ₹ 18,000 towards last instalment. This would be collected along with the fees collected in November 2027.

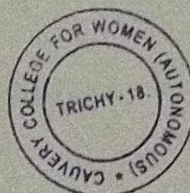
Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy shall collect the fees due from the students as per the above table at the beginning of every semester. FINSPIRE shall raise an invoice on the college to collect the same.

The IMA Fee is actually payable in US Dollars and have been converted at the current rates. Depending upon the exchange rates prevalent at the time of payment there may be some variations in the same.

Similar investment schedule shall be shared for every new batch at the time of commencement of the same.

Student Awareness & Enrolment

FINSPIRE will conduct awareness programmes for students of all three years of the B.Com and BBA programmes. Students interested in pursuing the US CMA pathway alongside graduation may voluntarily enrol.

Academic Accommodation

The programme shall ordinarily be delivered through live online classes. However, the initial preparatory programme may include a few live classroom sessions (normally not exceeding four or five sessions) to be conducted at the College premises. Accordingly, the College may provide academic accommodation to enrolled students by exempting them from attending their regular College classes during the scheduled FINSPIRE sessions. The regular academic timetable of the College shall remain unchanged, and only those students who voluntarily enroll for the programme shall avail such academic accommodation.

Proposed Class Schedule

- Tuesday: 9.00 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.
- Thursday: 9.00 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.
- Saturday: 8.00 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.
- Sunday: 8.00 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.

This schedule aligns with FINSPIRE's existing delivery model and enables Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy students to participate in the regular US CMA learning ecosystem with the same academic standards, faculty interaction and peer learning experience.

Academic Commitment

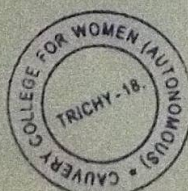
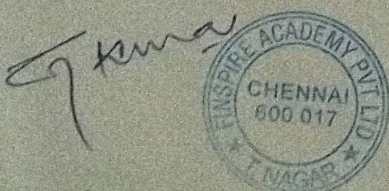
The proposed schedule will require participating students to be academically accommodated on a maximum of 30 academic days in each semester and not exceeding 100 academic hours in each of the first four semesters and approximately 60 academic hours during Semester 5, in accordance with the agreed academic plan.

Academic Calendar

No classes will ordinarily be conducted during November and April, enabling students to devote their full attention to the College Semester Examinations.

Attendance & Student Monitoring

FINSPIRE will maintain attendance for every session and submit monthly attendance and student progress reports to the College. Monthly progress reports will also be shared with parents so that the College and parents remain continuously informed regarding student participation and academic progress.

Dedicated Student Mentor

FINSPIRE will assign a dedicated Student Mentor, who will be a professionally qualified US CMA, exclusively for the students of Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy. The Mentor will serve as the single point of contact between the College, students and parents, monitor academic progress and examination preparedness, coordinate reporting, provide counselling and motivation, and proactively identify students requiring additional support.

Programme Coordinator

The College shall nominate a Programme Coordinator who shall act as the Single Point of Contact (SPOC) between the College and FINSPIRE. The Programme Coordinator shall facilitate coordination of class schedules, student communication, attendance-related matters and such other administrative support as may be reasonably required for the smooth implementation of the programme. In consideration of the coordination and administrative support so provided, FINSPIRE shall pay the College a coordination fee of Rs. 7,500 (Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred only) per enrolled student, payable in five instalments, proportionate to and aligned with the respective student fee instalments received by FINSPIRE.

Special Academic Support

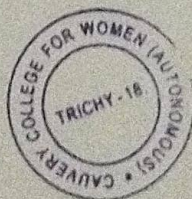
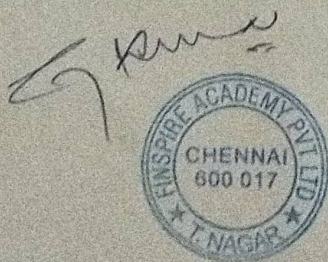
As a special academic support initiative, students of Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy will be permitted to attend one additional complete online cycle of classes for each CMA Part, without any additional investment. This provides an opportunity for comprehensive revision, concept reinforcement, doubt clarification and examination preparation. The number of hours including this support shall not exceed the timeframe indicated above. If additional academic support is considered necessary beyond the framework indicated above, the Parties may mutually discuss and agree upon appropriate arrangements.

Holiday Adjustment

If any scheduled FINSPIRE session falls on a declared College holiday, the session will be suitably accommodated within the FINSPIRE academic calendar so that it does not interrupt either the regular academic schedule or the additional academic support schedule.

Closing Thought

FINSPIRE does not seek to replace what Cauvery College for Women (Autonomous), Trichy has built over decades. It seeks to build upon that strong foundation and work alongside the College in creating a distinctive, globally relevant commerce education model that delivers lasting value to students, faculty, employers and society.
