MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into the 21st day of August 2026, by and between

CAUVERY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (Autonomous), THE FIRST PARTY, represented herein by its **Principal, Dr. S. Ramalakshmi** (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors, administrators, and assigns).

AND

GREENSOFT GROUPS, the Second Party, represented herein by its **Vice President, Trichy, Mr. M. Manoharan**, (hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**", which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context, shall include its successors, administrators, and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
(1) CAUVERY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (Autonomous)
- B) The First Party and the Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between them will promote the effective utilization of their respective resources and provide enhanced opportunities for mutual benefit.
- C) The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on collaboration in the areas of **skill-based training, projects, internships, workshops, and other similar activities**, with the objective of improving the **quality of education and strengthening Industry-Institute interaction**.
- D) Both Parties, being independent legal entities, desire to enter into this MOU for the advancement of their mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**CLAUSE 1
CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties share common interests and objectives and shall establish appropriate channels of communication and cooperation to promote and advance their respective activities. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share relevant information that may contribute to the development of mutually beneficial activities.
- 1.2 Cooperation between the First Party and the Second Party shall facilitate the effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of the First Party. The Second Party shall provide relevant industry inputs and guidance to support the development of suitable teaching and training systems aligned with current industry requirements.



- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. This MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof. In the event of any future specific engagements, the Parties will sign a separate agreement, as the case may be.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community in enhancing their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Skill Development Programs:** The Second Party shall guide and train the students of the First Party in emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and enhance their industry readiness.
- 2.3 **Project Guidance and Support:** The Second Party shall provide guidance, technical support, and mentorship to the students of the First Party in undertaking their academic and industry-oriented projects. The Second Party may facilitate project discussions, suggest suitable project topics, and provide necessary technical guidance based on the availability of resources and expertise.
- 2.4 **Internship Support:** The Second Party shall provide internship opportunities to eligible students of the First Party, subject to the availability of suitable internship positions and the eligibility criteria mutually agreed upon by both Parties. The internship shall provide students with practical exposure and industry experience relevant to their academic programme and career development.
- 2.5 **Placement Training of Students:** The Second Party shall actively engage in providing placement training to a limited number of students from the First Party, based on their academic performance and other eligibility criteria mutually agreed upon by both Parties.
- 2.6 **Placement:** The Second Party shall provide placement opportunities to eligible students. The eligibility and suitability of students shall be assessed through an appropriate selection process, including interviews.



Both Parties will obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programmes on the terms specified herein.

There is no financial commitment on the part of **CAUVERY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN(A)**, the First Party, to take up any programme mentioned in this MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt with separately.

CLAUSE 3 VALIDITY

- 3.1 This Agreement will be valid up on Three years from the date of signing and it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **GREENSOFT GROUPS**, the Second Party, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part **GREENSOFT GROUPS**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement, by way of communication, correspondence, etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 3.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties must discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 4 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 4.1 It is expressly agreed that the **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations, or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of, or binding upon, the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of arbitration shall be at Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Trichy.
