MINUTES

The meeting commenced with the prayer. The Chairman, Mr. K. Thiruneelakandan welcomed the gathering and initiated the proceedings of the Governing Body. The Principal of the Institution, Dr. V. Sujatha called the meeting to order.

Confirmation of the Minutes of the previous meeting & Action Taken Report based on the Fifth Meeting of the Governing Body

The minutes of the fifth meeting of the Governing Body held on February 25, 2022 were read and confirmed. The Action Taken Report based on the discussions of the previous meeting were recorded and confirmed.

Approval of Items:

RESOLUTION NO. 06/22/01

To consider and approve the Research Initiatives of the College by considering the 62 proposals received under seed money for selection for the Academic year 2022-2023. To increase the number of Paper Publications and Book / Chapter Publications and to enhance collaborative publication by promoting interdisciplinary research.

Resolved to approve the Research Initiatives of the College.

RESOLUTION NO. 06/22/02

To consider the recommendations of the Academic Council and approve

Mr. K. Thiruneelakandan Secretary, College Governing Council suggested to have a keen study of the result analysis and recommended to identify the difficulty of the students. He expressed the effect of Covid -19 in the student's academic learning activities and the struggle which educational institutions are facing to bring them to normalcy. He also shared the fear of the Parents to send the students appointed through placements for Jobs even to nearby cities.

To consider and approve The Financial Expenditure, the Minutes of the Sixth Meeting of the Finance Committee (2021 - 2022) and the Government Funds received by the faculty, the Management Grants extended to aid both the students and the faculty, the Fee concessions received by the students under the Government Scholarship and the fee concession by other Endowments.

ITEM NO: 06/22/05 New Initiatives and Future Directions

Principal Dr. V. Sujatha proposed the future plans of the institution and they were recorded.

ITEM NO: 06/22/06 Any other Matter with the permission of the Chair

UGC Representative Dr. K. K. Seethamma registered her happiness and congratulated saying that the deadly pandemic has not dampened the academic activities of the College. She recommended to develop the institution as the Green Institution with the introduction of the Organic lifestyles in curriculum along with energy efficient infrastructure, conservation, waste recycling etc.

Referring to the introduction of IGNOU's Professional development Programme, that aims to sensitize teachers inconsideration with the New Education Policy by creating a culture of research in Higher Education System; developing a focus on innovative methods that are continuous and comprehensive to assess the learning outcomes, She added that the programme aims at encouraging teachers to explore new Pedagogical approaches with innovative learner support system and create an enhanced learning environment. She recommended the faculty of the institution to register for the Programme.

UGC Representative Dr. K. K. Seethamma also insisted the new initiatives introduced by the Government such as KIRAN, and Women Scientist Scheme to improve the Gender ratio in Science and Technology. She encouraged the faculty members towards the Indo-US fellowships for women scientists in International Premium Institutions to enhance their research capabilities.

The Principal of the Institution, Dr. V. Sujatha registered the support extended by the management by giving salary, travel and accommodation allowance to the faculty members who receive fellowships.

Dr. G. Gopinath, Professor, University Representative from Bharathidasan University appreciating the activities of the EDC extended that the young entrepreneurs

can send their proposals for selection to the Bharathidasan University Entrepreneurship, Innovation and Career Hub (BECH) and get a seed money of 5 lakhs to implement their ideas. He clarified regarding the introduction of the courses from Swayam NPTEL platform as extra credit courses.

The Principal Dr. V. Sujatha explained the practical difficulty of inducing it in the curriculum due to Pandemic, and the inability to take over the same course in the next session.

Mr. K. Thiruneelakandan, Secretary of the College, explained the support given to the students who register for courses in Swayam NPTEL platform, by providing them bus facility to the exam centers and by reimbursing the fees of both the faculty members and Students who pass the Course as Toppers and with Elite+Gold and Elite+Silver.
