The meeting commenced with the prayer. The Chairman, Mr. K. Thiruneelakandan welcomed the gathering and initiated the proceedings of the Governing Body. The Principal of the Institution, Dr. V. Sujatha called the meeting to order.

Confirmation of the Minutes of the previous meeting & Action Taken Report based on the Sixth Meeting of the Governing Body

The minutes of the sixth meeting of the Governing Body held on September 15, 2022 were read and confirmed. The Action Taken Report based on the discussions of the previous meeting were recorded and confirmed.

Approval of Items:

RESOLUTION NO. 07/23/01

Dr. A. Gunasekaran, Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education, enquired about the result analysis and-the Mrs. V. Ramya, Controller of Examinations, referring to the failures in Chemistry presented their condition in which the pictorial representation was asked in the Question Paper and the marks could not be awarded to them as they presented it as theory. The impacts that affected the measures of education due to pandemic was discussed and reference was made about the student struggle to cope up. He also enquired about the Career Guidance and Placement cell and coaching giving by the College to crack competitive exams and Interviews.

The Principal Dr. V. Sujatha explained about the 30 hours of coaching for Placements and also referred to the NET oriented paper for the final years in the curriculum.

She asked to add courses such as Artificial Intelligence, Machine learning and Data Science to the existing list of value-added courses.

At this point, Dr. Sinthu Janita Prakash, Dean of Science, referred to the courses added in the B.Sc Programme and also expressed the difficulty of handling all such courses as Value Added Courses in a limited period of 30 hours.

Dr. G. Gopinath, Professor, Representative from Bharathidasan University enquired about the EDC and the various grants it received to cater innovation in the field of entrepreneurship. He appreciated the college activities and its efficient way of collecting and presenting valid data through the data capturing team.
