Being an Assessor of NAAC, Madam Principal evaluated the Qualitative and Quantitative inputs of AQAR 2020-2021 submitted online. Madam discussed with the criterion incharges about the quality enhancement measures to be undertaken.

Areas for Enhancement Criterion wise

CRITERION -1

Curricular Aspects

- More number of courses focusing on employability/Entrepreneurship and Skill development courses to be implemented in the syllabus.
- 2. Students' enrollment in Certificate courses to be increased.
- 3. Group projects to be introduced in final year undergraduate programmes.
- 4. Expertise training focusing on NET/SET/GATE/TNPSC Examination.
- 5. Value Added Courses to be offered at a phase of twice in a year.
- Implementing courses emphasizing on cross cutting issues related to Gender, professional ethics, human values, and environmental sustainability has to be implemented in PG programmes.
- 7. Employer and industrial expert feedbacks to be sought.
- 8. Internship/field trip has to be implemented for all the Programmes.
